ERASMUS+ MOBILITY FOR STUDY and SEMP



ERASMUS+ MOBILITY FOR STUDY is a program in the field of education promoted and financed by the EU for the period 2014-2020. It will give to more than 4million persons the possibility to study and train abroad.

You will be able to:

- undertake a learning experience in **another European country**
- spend one or two semesters abroad
- get acquainted with other academic systems
- experience new study methods
- obtain recognition of the activities carried out during the mobility period



The same student may participate in the **Erasmus+ mobility project** up to 12 months maximum for each study cycle (Ba, Ma). The minimum requirement to be considered an Erasmus student is a 3 months mobility (90 days).

What can you do while abroad with Erasmus+ for Study? Take courses, sit exams, prepare a thesis research, do an internship

Swiss European Mobility Programme (SEMP)

Differences with Erasmus+ Study programme:

- ✓ Funded by the Swiss Government, not from the EU
- ✓ Mobility period out of the Erasmus+ mobility (min 3 − max 12 months)



Who can apply, when and how



1) GENERAL CRITERIA COMMON TO ALL UNIPD STUDENTS

- ✓ Regularly enrolled
- ✓ EU citizen and Extra EU citizen
- ✓ VISA and PERMIT OF STAY
- ✓You can't benefit at the same time of two european grants

SPECIFIC CRITERIA at DSEA

Merit rating & Language proficiency:

Very important

- You can choose up to **3 destinations** in both calls for application
- You will be selected for the one in which your ranking position will be higher

3) HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT DESTINATION

First of all: coherence between study programmes Then: previous knowledge of the language of instruction and personal interests

Together with the Erasmus and SEMP call a list of partner Universities will be published!

- 1) On the excel list, filter by Degree course title
- 2) Filter by language of instruction
- 3) Visit the websites of the Universities you're interested in and compare their list of exams with the exams you have to take next academic year



What do you have to upload on the application from on Uniweb?

- 1) PDF COPY OF YOUR ID CARD/RESIDENCE PERMIT (mandatory)
- 2) PDF OF YOUR PURPOSED PLAN OF STUDY ABROAD (mandatory)
- 3) PDF OF A LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE (only if you have it. Not mandatory)

How to prepare your purposed plan of study

✓ Print your Manifesto degli Studi and highlight the courses belonging to next academic year

✓ Find a coherence between these courses and the ones you'll find in the course catalogues of the Universities you chose.
 Courses can match for title/content/scientifica area

✓1 semester: 30 ECTS (=CFU) 2 semesters: 60 ECTS (=CFU)

 \checkmark Fill in the form with the titles of the courses and credits

✓ This provisional plan is mandatory. Please remember that you're allowed to change it up to 4 times once you win the grant basing on the final course catalogue published by the host university



Language proficiency

✓ EC fixed an "ideal" threshold level: B1 (lower intermediate)
 ✓ Every partner University fixes its own criteria about language proficiency and states if this level has to be certified or not

So... Check info on *Lista flussi* Double check on universities websites

You can apply without any language certification but please note that you'll be awarded with extra points (from 1 to 5) if you can proof your language proficiency.

✓ Online Linguistic Support – OLS

Free test and course designed to assist Erasmus+ participants in improving their knowledge of the language in which they will study abroad.

- available for German, English, Spanish, French, Italian and Dutch
- Mandatory
- you'll receive a login and a password to access the OLS platform

How it works:

•assessment before the mobility

•based on the assessment results, you'll have access to an online language course before and during your stay abroad

•final assessment which will allow you to measure the progress made during your mobility period



Funding



The Erasmus scholarship is a contribution offered by the EU in order to support the mobility period. It is not a full funding of your expenses!

Grants are defined depending on the geographic area of the chosen destination country.

Very important:

- ✓ You won't pay fees at the host University
- ✓You will still pay Unipd fees

✓ If you won't pass any exam abroad (minimum 9 credits) you will have to give back your grant but your Erasmus students status will be guarantee ("zero grant" mobility)
