Presentation

The 3rd edition of the Brixen Workshop & Summer School on International Trade and Finance will be held in Bressanone/Brixen from September 16 to September 22, 2012. The Summer School will consist of a set of lectures on Recent Developments in International Trade and Economic Geography by eminent scholars in this field while the Workshop will be devoted to the presentation and discussion of working papers presented by selected participants.

Tuition and Accommodation fees

The Brixen Workshop & Summer School is funded partly by sponsors and partly by tuition fees. The 2012 tuition fee is € 200. Full accommodation is provided by the Accademia Cusano/Cusanus Akademie, Piazza Seminario 2, Bressanone/Brixen (http://www.cusanus.bz.it). The full accommodation fee is €300. The fee also includes the Welcome dinner of September 16, the Farewell dinner of September 21 at the Hotel Grunerbaum, the overnight stay of September 21 and the breakfast of September 22.

Some **scholarships** to cover the entire tuition fee of € 200 will be awarded in particular cases.

The fee payment of €500 (or of €300, if selected for a scholarship) has to be made by **July 31, 2012**. Students who will not have sent their email soon after admission or who will not have made their due payment by July 31 will be replaced by applicants in the waiting list.

The Workshop & Summer School will take place at the Accademia Cusano/Cusanus Akademie, Piazza Seminario 2. **Bressanone/Brixen** is a small bi-lingual South Tyrol city located in the valley of the Isarc river and surrounded by the beautiful Dolomiti mountains.

Travel

How to reach Bressanone/Brixen:

Closest airports: Innsbruck (Austria); Verona; Munich (Germany); Venezia; Milano; (Linate or Malpensa); Brescia



By plane + train:

If your flight is to **VERONA**: take the train from VERONA/PORTA NUOVA to BRESSANONE. Frequency of trains: one per hour; averaged duration: 2:10 h.;

If your flight is to **MUNICH** (GERMANY): take the train from München Hbf to BRESSANONE via INNSBRUCK/BRENNERO. Frequency of trains: one per two hours; averaged duration: 3:30 h.

If your flight is to **MILANO**: take the train from MILANO/STAZIONE CENTRALE to BRESSANONE via VERONA . Frequency of

trains: one per hour; averaged duration: 3:50 h; possible changes: Verona .

If your flight is to **VENEZIA**:: take the train from VENEZIA/MESTRE to BRESSANONE via VERONA . Frequency of trains: almost one per hour; averaged duration: 3:50 h.; possible changes: Verona .

If your flight is to **ROME**: take the train from ROMA/STAZIONE TERMINI to BRESSANONE via FIRENZE/BOLOGNA/VERONA. Frequency of trains: almost one per two hours; averaged duration: 7 h.; possible changes: Bologna.

If your flight is to **INNSBRUCK**: take the train from Innsbruck Hbf to Bressanone/Brixen via Brennero. Frequency of trains: one per two hours; averaged duration: 1:40 h.
