Students who are **not native speakers** will be asked to demonstrate their ability to study in English. We welcome TOEFL and IELTS or Cambridge tests or official confirmation from the home university. **The required level of language knowledge is B2.**

Courses Registration

Students can enrol in both bachelor's and master's degree courses regardless of their academic level. There could be some course exceptions.

The list of the chosen subjects must be approved by the student's home Faculty.

Important notes

- Students have to take a minimum of 51% of the courses at the Faculty they are nominated to.
- Students will be able to register online to the courses only upon their arrival during the Orientation week.
- Students have to pay attention to the last letter of the subject code. "B" stands for the Bachelor's level. "M" stands for the Master's level, "D" stands for PhD. students

Czech Language Classes

We offer <u>Czech language classes</u> at various levels, from Beginners to Upper Intermediate. Incoming students are welcome to register for these. However, we must point out that, because these classes are not part of the standard curriculum, they are not financed by the Czech Ministry of Education. We therefore have to make a small charge to cover our costs.

Academic Transcripts or Records

Academic Transcripts will be provided by the International office to every student automatically at the end of each semester.

Housing

Erasmus students are welcome to apply for accommodation at Charles University Halls of Residence, the online application form includes a housing option. More information can be found here: https://kam.cuni.cz/KAMEN-1.html.

Deposit & Costs

We ask your nominees to confirm their housing reservation by paying a deposit of 1800 CZK (approx. 70 €) plus the price for 1 month at a dormitory 3800 CZK (approx. 140 - 150 €).

Visa to the Czech Republic

Students from non-EU and non-EFTA countries will need a student visa. To obtain their visa in a timely manner, we strongly recommend students to send their applications in **as early as possible**. Visa arrangement process may take up to 3 months.

Note

- Semester-length students should apply for a student visa (long-stay visa for the purpose of study)
- Full year students (2 semesters) should apply for a long-term residence permit
