

ELECTIVE COURSES

Incoming Exchange students are able to take electives, but not "core" courses. Students should also note prerequisite requirements for all classes as there is a process for getting into these courses.

FULL COURSE LOAD

The minimum full-time course load requirement is 12 Ross credits. The maximum is 18 credits and students average taking 15 credits per semester.

The University of Michigan requires students to have demonstrated proficiency in English. Minimum requirements as suggested by the University are:

- IELTS: 6.5-7.0 range
- TOEFL (PBT): 600






ROSS FACILITIES

INTERNATIONAL CENTER (IC)


UM has a central office that supports incoming students called the International Center. You can access visa resources, social events, and general advice from the IC.

Ann Arbor has a population of over 330,000, including 51,000 UM students


Ann Arbor is consistently ranked as one of the best cities to live in the US!
