






INTENSIVE SUMMER CLASSES


CLASSES & FINAL EXAMS


Moodle

E-learning platform, to download information, teaching material and assessment.

<u>Uniweb</u>

Web platform, to enrol to exams (from 20 to 3 days before the exam), accept/refuse marks and get the credits for the final transcript of records.







TWO INTAKES (APPELLI)

You have 2 chances to pass each exam: the first and second intake (appello).

If you want to refuse the grade, you can do it in 7 days. After 7 days, results (expressed in grade /30) will be published on-line - using Uniweb platform.

The minimum to pass an exam is 18/30.







AT THE END OF YOUR STAY

Three steps to finalize your Erasmus stay:

1) Obtain your Transcript of Records (on-line request)

2) Final interwiew (Uniweb)

3) Confirmation of Stay/Attendance Certificate (<u>Central International Relations Office, Palazzo Bo – go</u> <u>personally</u>)


