- ✓ Scholarship: around 500€/month



- ✓ USA, New York
- ✓ Double degree in Finance
- ✓ For Business Administration AF and Economics and Finance BF, 5 scholarships
- ✓ Full second year abroad
- ✓ Fees to be paid also in US (about 18.000 US dollar)

Call for selection will be published by dSEA in mid-November.

Selection will close in December and the criteria will be based on the score obtained in the selection for the master's courses for the A.Y. 2020-21, on a motivational interview (the competence of English language will also be evaluated) and on the basis of previous international experiences.



Call for selection will be published by dSEA in mid-November. Selection will be conducted both by dSEA and ZSB.

Candidates must have in their Top high score grades in:

- micro and macroeconomics
- econometrics
- statistics

2. Overseas exchanges – selection process

Selection criteria will be based on the score obtained in the selection for the master's courses for the A.Y. 2020-21, on a motivational interview (the competence of English language will also be evaluated) and on the basis of previous international experiences.

2 steps:

- application in Uniweb within mid-January 2021
- motivational interview with dSEA Commission



The call for selection will be published in mid-November 2020:

Ulisse Program:

The Ulisse call for selection will also contain the Overseas **destinations at University level** (the selection will be conducted by the central International Relations Division)



- ✓ 2 weeks in Guangzhou between June and July
- ✓ Course «Intercultural management: theory and practice» 6 ECTS (elective course)
- ✓ Chinese language course before leaving
- ✓ Selection call published by dSEA in February-March, candidates are selected according to their academic records and through a motivational interview





Erasmus+

- ✓ The Erasmus+ for Study program allows students to spend a study period abroad (between 3 and 12 months) during their second year hosted by a partner university in Europe without paying additional fees;
- ✓ The Erasmus Grant is funded by the European Commission (about 300€/month beside the possibility to receive additional funds from UNIPD if eligible for financial benefits);
- ✓ The Erasmus+ Study call for selection will be published in February/March 2021.
