Standard timetable

- Semester of classes (Sept. - Dec. 2021)
- Semester for internship (Jan. - June 2022)
- Thesis defense - end of internship (June/July/September 2022)
- ESC Clermont Business School “jury” - Oct./Nov. 2022
- Graduation ceremony - April/May 2023

Master's Thesis

3 scenarios

1. You can adhere to the ESC Clermont schedule. I will be your thesis supervisor. You will receive the diploma in the ceremony scheduled for April/May 2023. You probably will have to do the thesis defense in Italy as well.
2. You finish, submit, and defend your thesis in Pavia/Padova, and the university sends the result before the jury in ESC Clermont. We accept the result, and you will have met the requirements. You will receive the diploma in the ceremony scheduled for April/May 2023.
3. If you miss jury deadline, all is not lost. All it does is postpone the diploma by one year. Your university sends the result before the **next** jury in ESC Clermont. You will receive a document stating that you have met the requirements for the Master's degree, and the diploma will be conferred in April 2024.
