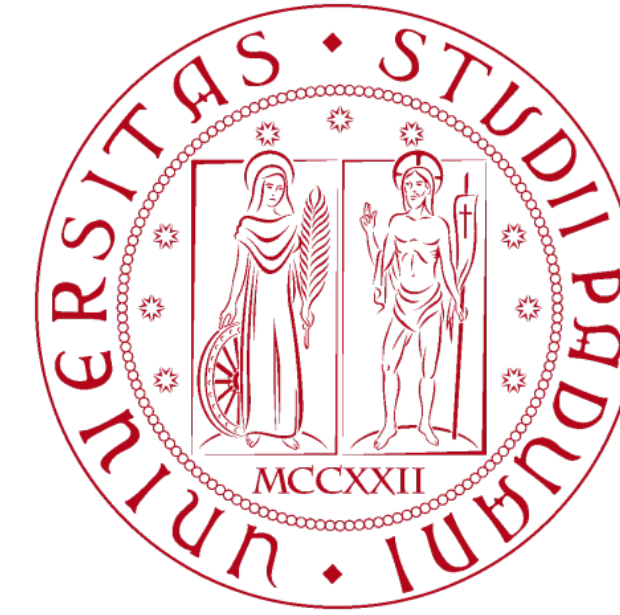

Standard timetable

Master's Thesis

3 scenarios

1. You can adhere to the Clermont schedule. You will receive the diploma in the ceremony scheduled for April/May 2027. You probably will have to do the thesis defense in Italy as well.
2. You finish, submit, and defend your thesis in Pavia/Padova, and the university sends the result before the jury in Clermont. We accept the result, and you will have met the requirements. You will receive the diploma in the ceremony scheduled for April/May 2027.
3. If you miss jury deadline, all is not lost. All it does is postpone the diploma by one year. Your university sends the result before the **next** jury in Clermont. You will receive a document stating that you have met the requirements for the Master's degree, and the diploma will be conferred in April 2028.

Master's Degree students' thesis can be evaluated as follows:

- - from 1 up to 3 points: means that the thesis work is considered "sufficient";
- - from 4 up to 6 points: means that the thesis work is considered "good";
- - from 7 up to 9 points: means that the thesis work is considered "very good";
- - 10 points: means that the thesis work is considered "excellent".
