
Required Application Documents

- Copy of Passport
- Spanish B1 certificate for exchange, if your native language is not Spanish and you will take courses in this language. Spanish B2 certificate for double degree.
- English B1 (in case your maternal language isn't English and you wish to take English taught courses)
- Official Transcripts of records

Required documents (once accepted)

- International Medical Insurance
 - Medical assistance in case of illness with coverage for USD \$30,000
 - Medical assistance in the event of an accident with coverage for USD \$30,000
 - Repatriation during the period of mobility even if it is extended.
 - *Medical/Health repatriation
 - * Repatriation of mortal remains
- Ticket leaving the country (Colombia), for mobility of less than or equal to one semester.

COURSE REGISTRATION

International students must register their courses in the dates that will be informed once they have their acceptance letter and their URosario passport (correo@urosario.edu.co)

- 1. Undergraduate and Postgraduate Exchange Program: The students can enroll minimum one course and up to a maximum of 18 credits.
- 2. Double Degree: Students must follow the guidelines established in the agreement.

MIGRATION PROCESS

IF YOUR STAY AT UNIVERSIDAD DEL ROSARIO IS LESS THAN 6 MONTHS

For stays of less than 6 months you do not need a student visa to enter the country. Upon entering the country, a Colombian Immigration agent will place a PID (Permission for Integration and Development) stamp in your passport. This applies to nationalities exempt from visa requirements to enter Colombia.

Note: If the mobility includes a practical course, you will have to obtain a Student Visa and then the Cédula de Extranjería in order to be affiliated to the ARL (Administradora de Riesgos Laborales).

IF YOUR STAY AT UNIVERSIDAD DEL ROSARIO IS LONGER THAN 6 MONTHS (1 SEMESTER)

You must request a visa, according to the type of activities that you will do in our country. Please check the step by step and the documents for the request in the next link: http://www.cancilleria.gov.co/tramites_servicios/visa

The visa process also applies to nationalities that require a visa to enter Colombia, regardless of the duration of their stay in the country.
