- 15 MINUTES WALK TO THE NEAREST TRAIN STATION

<FACILITIES>

- ONE UNIT INCLUDES 4 PRIVATE ROOMS, A KITCHEN AND A DINING ROOM
- SHARED LAUNDRY

<COST>

- 37,800 YEN/MONTH (INCL. COMMON SERVICE CHARGE, WATER & UTILITIES)
- INTERNET ACCESS IS EXTRA CHARGE.

STEP BY STEP PROCEDURE FOR THE EXCHANGE STUDENTS

STEP 1

- Application via the international office at each university.

STEP 2

- Application for Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) is submitted to the immigration bureau in Osaka by Global Exchange Office on behalf of you.

STEP 3

- Letter of Acceptance issued by OMU and CoE is to be sent to the international office of your home university.

STEP 4

- Apply for the dormitory.

STEP 5

- Apply for visa at the Japanese embassy in your country.

STEP 6

- Book the flight and send the itinerary to OMU.

STEP BY STEP PROCEDURE FOR THE EXCHANGE STUDENTS

STEP 7

- Arrival at Kansai airport or another international airport in Japan.

STEP 8

- Picking up service by OMU students or staffs is available at Kansai airport or another point in Osaka.

STEP 9

- Moving in procedure is to be followed by the manager at the dormitory.

STEP 10

- Registration procedure as a new resident at the ward office is to be done within two weeks after your entry in Japan. OMU students or staffs will help you for it.

STEP 11

- Guidance for the exchange students about the life in Japan or at OMU is to be held by OMU staffs.
