- **Online application** at Baruch College (application fee: \$75). You will be charged tuition and fees once admitted and registered for the two courses in summer.

✓ Language certificate

- Since your Master's degree classes are held in English and your English proficiency will be evaluated through Baruch College motivational interviews, **no English language certificate is required** from your side.

✓ Contributions and financial benefits

- Unipd scholarship: around **700€/month** (waiting for approval)
- Contribution to travel expenses: around **820€** (waiting for approval)
- One-time **reimbursement for expenses: 6.000€/ top five students** (dSEA)

- ✓ Complete 1 year exams in Padua **before your departure**

- ✓ Learning Agreement
 - You are required to **submit your Learning Agreement (LA)** via Uniweb platform before leaving for the Usa. The LA represents a plan linked the exams you intend to take during your mobility period
 - Your LA **must be approved** by prof. Antonietti before your departure.
 - Your LA **can subject to changes before** (1 max) and **during** the mobility (2 max), at the beginning of the scheduled term at Baruch College
