









Curriculum (International Business)


Principles of credit transfer

- For IB students, you will earn at least 20 credits from courses offered by Fudan SOE. For Finance students, at least 18 credits from courses offered by Fudan SOE.
- You will take the General Basic Courses of 7 credits at Fudan.
- For the Compulsory Degree Courses, you can transfer to Fudan your courses taken during phase one at UNIPD, based on the list of substitutes. For IB, at least 13 credits should be earned at Fudan. For Finance, at least 6 credits should be earned at Fudan.
- The Compulsory Courses transferred to Fudan will have a similar title than that of UNIPD.
- For the optional courses, for Finance students you have to take at least 5 credits at Fudan, including “China’s Financial System”. Transfer 11 credits from phase one at UNIPD. IB students can transfer 8 credits from phase one.

Thesis rules

- Written and defended in English
- Around 20,000 words (Finance) or 25,000 words (International Business)
- Under the supervision of your supervisor & the defense committee
- Meet the format requirements of Graduate School

Eligibility

- ✓ Bachelor's degree or above

Completion of a bachelor's or higher degree program from an accredited college or university.

- ✓ Relevant background for 2 years program

Majored in economics or finance or business related fields & solid knowledge in mathematics during the previous degree study.

- ✓ High English language proficiency in both speaking and writing.

Indicators: TOEFL (IBT) ≥ 90 , IELTS ≥ 6.5 , Duolingo English Test ≥ 110 , PTE Academic ≥ 61

*You do not need to provide evidence of English language proficiency if you meet one of the following criteria: A. Your first language is English; or B. You have completed, or are completing, a degree-level course taught and assessed entirely in English.

- ✓ Non-Chinese nationality.

- ✓ 1+1 Double degree program applicants need to be nominated by our partner universities (view the partner list on EMA website). First year at partner university, second year at Fudan.

Shanghai Government Scholarship (SGS)

All applicants are welcomed to send the application to Fudan University.

Please note that the university will recommend the best applicants only and there is no guarantee that the recommended applicants will be awarded the scholarship.

Admission Scholarship

The program will identify qualified new students after entry based on academic performance and the admission evaluation results.

The amount of the Admission Scholarship ranges up to half of the paid annual tuition of the student.

Dean's Scholarship

At the end of each academic year, exceptionally outstanding students of the EMA programs at SOE will be awarded Dean's Scholarship according to their academic performance of the previous year.

The amount of the Dean's Scholarship ranges up to half of the paid annual tuition

Other scholarships

More scholarships are available to outstanding students, e.g. IBM, China Development Bank, Fudan Boxue Scholarship, Confucius Institute Belt and Road Scholarship, etc.
