The establishment of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Shenzhen is an initiative to extend the CUHK core educational philosophy and values beyond Hong Kong, in order to contribute to higher education across China and to groom future generations of university graduates who are international in outlook, learned in the disciplines they follow, upright character, and committed to serving the needs of society.

CUHK-Shenzhen inherits the educational philosophy and academic systems of The Chinese University of Hong Kong. It is intended to evolve into a world class research university with strong Chinese cultural influence. It is committed to nurturing high-end talents with global perspective, Chinese tradition and social responsibility.

At present, the University has programmes in science, engineering, economic management, and humanities and social science. Its long term goal is to recruit 11,000 domestic and international students, 7,500 of whom will be undergraduate students and 3,500 Masters and PhD students.

COLLEGES

CUHK is the only university in Hong Kong with a collegiate system consisting of nine Colleges with their own administrative systems and unique features. CUHK-Shenzhen adopts the same collegiate system. Currently there are four colleges, namely Shaw College, Diligentia College, Muse College and Harmonia College. Each College is distinctive, but together they shape the character of the CUHK-Shenzhen. Students are assigned to different Colleges where their overall quality will be nurtured and developed. Each college accommodates up to 2,400 students. In addition, CUHK-Shenzhen graduate, exchange and visiting students are also housed in the Colleges.

DISTINGUISHED SCHOLARS

CUHK has more than 7,000 faculty members and staff, among which the faculty are the world's most highly regarded academics from a variety of fields, including Nobel Laureates, a Turing Award Winner, a Fields Medalist, and Academicians of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering. Professor Charles K. Kao, former Vice-Chancellor of CUHK, was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 2009.

EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

The first student exchange programme was launched in 1965 with the University of California. Since then, student exchange programmes have been established with over 230 institutions, including universities, research institutes, centers of learning, governmental agencies and regional and international associations of higher learning. As a leading international university, CUHK is a member of the Worldwide University Network, a founding member of the Asia Pacific Association for International Education (APAIE), and a part of a number of other key educational bodies.

DISTINGUISHED SCHOLARS

- The curriculum is offered extensively in English with the exception of the Chinese languages course. International students can opt to study Chinese at various entry levels.
- The fall and spring semesters are divided by Christmas / New Year for easy exchanges and holiday observations.

CREDIT UNIT SYSTEM

The four-year (normative) curriculum is built on a credit unit system, with flexibility and choices both in the selection of courses and in the sequence of electives. The university's general education curriculum provides students with a broad intellectual perspective and an opportunity to understand the value of different academic disciplines.







LIFE IN **SHENZHEN**



Shenzhen is a thriving metropolis in the south coast of China. Its subtropical environment not only created a city crammed with greenery, but also innovation and technology. Shenzhen is the fast developing city in China with an annual GDP growth of 9.3% and GDP over 350 billion USD. Shenzhen is home to over eleven million people with an average age at 29 which ranked as China' most dynamic city.

Mega malls and public buildings are the main landscape of Shenzhen. Favored by locals, COCO Park, CR Vientiane City Plaza, Yitian Holiday Plaza, Haiya Mega Mall, Coastal City is fulfilled with products and cuisine from worldwide.

Meanwhile, Shenzhen is rich in history of the Hakka and Cantonese. Several ancient landmarks in the city including traditional Hakka enclosed houses Dawan Building, Dapeng Fortress, Crane Lake Hakka Village, etc.
