COURSES TAUGHT IN ENGLISH AT FSV UK

The Faculty of Social Sciences at Charles University has 5 institutes:

- Institute of Political Studies
- Institute of International Studies
- Institute of Economic Studies
- Institute of Sociological Studies
- Institute of Communication Studies and Journalism

All nominated students will receive a list of courses taught in English available for the academic year. Courses from other Faculties can be searched also via our <u>online system SIS</u>.

COURSES REGISTRATION

Students can enrol in both Bachelor's and Master's degree courses regardless of their academic level.

Important notes

- ✓ Students have to take a minimum of 51% of the courses at the Faculty they are nominated to.
- ✓ Students will be able to register online to the courses only upon their arrival during the Orientation week.
- ✓ Students have to pay attention to the last letter of the subject code. "B" stands for the Bachelor's level. "M" stands for the Master's level, "D" stands for PhD. students

CZECH LANGUAGE COURSE FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

We offer Czech language classes from Beginners to Upper Intermediate. However, we must point out that, because these classes are not part of the standard curriculum, they are not financed by the Czech Ministry of Education. Therefore, there is a small charge to cover our costs.
