Nominations	Exchange Coordinators nominate students by completing and returning the nomination form (as attached) via email to incoming@sufe.edu.cn before the deadlines. Upon receipt of the nominations an email will be sent to nominees to instruct online application procedures within two weeks.
Applications	All nominees complete an online-application and submit supplementary documentation: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. a print out of the online application form with applicant's signature; 2. a copy of transcript of record relating to recent studies; 3. proof of English/Chinese language proficiency if applicable-for language requirements details see below) by post before the deadlines. All application credentials shall be collected as one group and sent by post to Ms. Jiaying Yang (for contact details see the column below).

Admissions	Admission decisions made around June (for autumn-semester exchange) and December (for spring-semester exchange), with offer packages sent to the sending institutions for further distribution to each individual student.

Academic Requirements	No specific GPA / levels of academic achievements to be met. Academic backgrounds in at least one of the areas across Economics/ Management / Information Science / Engineering / Laws/ Social Sciences are expected.
Language Requirements	For Candidates whose first language is not English or Chinese, an additional letter of approval from the home institution attesting sufficient skills qualified for undertaking exchange is required for completing their applications, alternatively, an IELTS score of at least 6.0 (or TOEFL 80 equivalent) or HSK Level 3 shall also qualify for admission.
