> One topic DOES NOT NECESSARILY imply only one dissertation: a single topic can be developed by multiple students.

Every professor has a given number of students to supervise depending on:

- his/her academic activities
- his/her employment relationship with the University
- his/her Department



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Select the thesis 1/2

- > BEFORE the selection procedure opens:
- 1. Read carefully all the topics
- 2. Contact the professors (it is strongly suggested!) in order to make a careful choice

> At the **beginning of March**, 2025) the selection procedure will open





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Select the thesis 2/2



> You can select a topic **only** if you have **70 CFU**.

> Note that:

- You will be required to rank your first 3 choices (max).
- For every choice, you must fill in a brief form indicating:
 - Reasons for choosing the topic (BE SMART!)
 - Career information

After your selection

➤ After you have done your selection, your first choice supervisor receives an email with your details.

> The Professor has 15 days to:

APPROVE YOUR REQUEST



EXPRESS A MOTIVATED REJECTION

What are the 15 days for?

Usually (but it is not mandatory) professors use these days for a short selection procedure (e.g. interviews).



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Can my request be rejected?



In case of:

- The supervisor receiving a number of requests higher than his/her maximum threshold
- Student not meeting minimum skills requirements to elaborate the topic

The Professor may reject your request!

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In case your first choice is rejected...



The previous procedure will be automatically activated for your **second** (and, eventually, **third**) **choice**.

In case your first, second, and third choice is rejected...



You'll have to express new preferences among the remaining topics.

Under no circumstances will you be able to propose a topic of your choice to any of the Professors.

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After the approval



Within a **maximum of 30 days** after approval, the student must contact the Professor to start the project.

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Content (general info) 1/2



You are expected to develop:

- An original document of roughly 80 pages
- in English (in Italian only for students enrolled in curriculum Consulenza e Direzione Aziendale - MAFIB)
- Under the supervision of a Professor (Supervisor)

Content (general info) 2/2

The main features of a thesis are:



- An accurate description of the chosen theme
- Bibliographic research

- Critical review of relevant literature
- Application of theoretical knowledge and / or empirical analysis (e.g. case study, statistical analysis, interviews...)

Formatting your document

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- Layout (line spacing, margins, font)
- Declaration of authenticity (Anti-Plagiarism Rules)
- Confidentiality commitment
- Cover page

- > There is **no** need to submit a printed copy
- > After the submission you will be assigned a Discussant

Anti-Plagiarism Rules and Declaration of Authenticity

Anti-plagiarism rules



With the Anti-Plagiarism rules, the Department intends to promote and ensure the students' duty to write their thesis in full respect of copyright and intellectual property.

Declaration of Authenticity

On the page following the title page of the thesis, must be inserted the "Declaration of Authenticity" signed by the candidate, in the absence of which the Supervisor cannot, under any circumstances, approve the paper which cannot, therefore, be submitted for the degree examination.

Thesis evaluation (/110)

- > 7/110: maximum score that can be awarded to the final dissertation;
- > the evaluation will take into account the quality and originality of the thesis, as well as its presentation and discussion;
- > Additional points:
 - o **3/110**: graduation in July or October;
 - o **2/110**: graduation in December;
 - o 1/110: graduation in March;
- > cum Laude can be awarded only if:
 - o after the discussion the evaluation is the maximum (7/110);
 - final grade (before the dissertation mark) is not less than 105/110 (including the additional points);
 - upon the recommendation of the Discussant...

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Application for graduation via Uniweb

- ➤ In addition to the previously described procedure, you must fill in an **Application for Graduation** early in the semester in which you intend to graduate.
- > Applications for Graduation must be submitted electronically via **Uniweb**.
- Each electronic Application for Graduation will result in a € 16.00 nonrefundable charge on your student's bill.
