




Lessons I have to attend my courses

- ☐ E-learning system: MOODLE
 - Check the website <u>https://elearning.unipd.it/economia</u>
 - Course program, teaching materials, case studies, exercises, articles, resources in order to get ready for your exams!
 - Credentials to access are the same as in Uniweb
- ☐ If I don't understand... can I talk to my professor?
 - You can fix an appointment during office hours and can write an e-mail



A little «excursus» Writing e-mail: netiquette!

- Professors, tutors, office staff...
 - Are not your friends and/or your family!
 - So... the language must be different to that used on Facebook or on a text message (SMS)
 - It's a matter of education and respect
 - ✓ It is also a question of receiving an "appropriate answer" as a poorly written email reduces the chances of receiving a reply.

To contact the administrative offices, the professors and the university staff, you should use the e-mail address that you received at the time of enrollment.

Writing e-mail: netiquette! Look at some **BAD** examples

- □ Hi, I just enrolled at Economics and Finance. I know that the courses are about to start. Where do I need to go to attend the courses?
- □ Hi, talking with some friends I overheard that professor XXX is offering an opportunity for students to participate in a project work. Can you tell me something about it?



Writing e-mail: netiquette! Look at some **GOOD** examples

Dear Tutor,

I am a second year student of the Master's program in Business Administration. Next month I will have to choose my electives, and I would like to get some information with respect to the possibilities which are offered by the Department of Economics and Management. Furthermore, it is not clear to me wether I can attend electives in other Departments of the University of Padova. If it is possible I would like to have a meeting with you in order to clarify my doubts.



A little «excursus» Writing e-mail: netiquette!

Common sense rules

- Start your e-mail in a proper way
 - ✓ Dear prof., Dear sir.
- Introduce yourself
 - ✓ I am John Doe, student of the first year of MEF
- Present your doubts in a clear and respectful way
- Close your mail with an appropriate greeting
 - ✓ Best regards, Kind regards
- Sign with your name and your identification number
 - ✓ Jon Doe, 123456 MEF

Exams I passed the exam


"I have done my exam: where are the results published?"

- ☐ The professors publish the results of the exam on uniweb.
- □ As they publish the results, you will receive an e-mail with your grade and some rules
 - □ At a specific area of the Uniweb, you have 7 days for
 - Checking the results
 - Rejecting the result (irreversible!)
- Be careful: the general rule is SILENT CONSENT. If after 7 days you DO NOT reject (explicitly) the grade, than it will be automatically considered as tacit acceptance. Then it will enter in your "libretto"

Exams I failed my exam

"I took the exam... but I failed!"

- ☐ Assuming that the reason is not due to poor study
 - Plan your exams and your study: you can't do everything in one session!
 - Talk with the tutor!


ASEA Structure of Master's courses 1° Year




